Auction closes on the 15th April, 2026

Now we are looking forward to increasing temperatures and the emerging signs of spring it is also time to check out the offerings in the April auction of the Society which again offers some interesting and scarce items. However, some reminders could be useful to help with the running of the auction. Please ensure your lot numbers are clear and obvious as it is easy to mistake 1's for 7's etc. It is also necessary for the reserves to be clearly observed as are the bidding steps noted on the rear of the bidding form. Postage is becoming far too complicated at present with Royal Mail making regular alterations to the postage and the compensation amounts. Both 1st class (£1.70) and Signed For (£3.60) at the lowest weight step both offer the same compensation of £20 with Tracked 24 and 48 now lowered to £75 from £150 and only available for Large Letters and above. If possible, I will contact buyers of larger and more valuable lots to check on their choice of postage.
